Through programs like Elevate Academy, RBI provides free access to courses, coaching, and career training designed specifically for survivors. These opportunities help individuals move from crisis to stability.

The RBI trains thousands of law enforcement officers, service providers, and community professionals to recognize trafficking more effectively and respond with trauma-informed care.
